Day 1 : Delhi

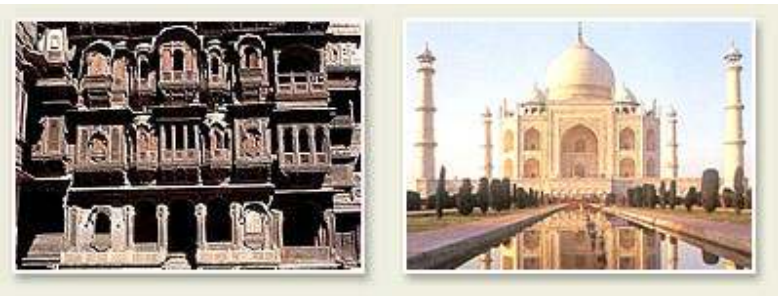
Arrive in Delhi late night / early morning. Check in at hotel for overnight stay.

Day 01: Delhi

Arrive in New Delhi. You will be met at the airport and transferred to the hotel for overnight.

Day 02: Srinagar

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight to Srinagar.

Arrive in the beautiful valley and transfer to Super Deluxe Houseboat.

KASHMIR Kashmir is one of the most beautiful regions of India. The Mughal rulers of India were always happy to retreat from the heat of the plains to the cool green heights of Kashmir. The Mughals developed their formal garden-style art to its greatest heights in Kashmir and some of their gardens are beautifully kept even to this day. One of Kashmir's greatest attractions is undoubtedly the Dal Lake houseboat, Srinagar – the capital of Kashmir stands on Dal Lake and stay on the houseboat, Srinagar – the capital of Kashmir stands on Dal Lake and the Jhelum River, and is the transport hub for the valley. It is crowded, colourful city with a distinctly central – Asian flavour.

In the afternoon, enjoy shikara ride on Dal Lake. These are the graceful, long boats, which crowd the Srinagar Lake. The waters of Dal Lake are amazingly clear.

Overnight in the houseboat.

Day 03: Kashmir

After breakfast, depart for sightseeing of Srinagar city visiting Jhelum River, Shri Pratap Singh Museum, Pathar Masjid and Shankaracharya Hill.

Return to the houseboat for lunch.

In the afternoon, enjoy another shikara ride on Dal Lake.

Overnight in the houseboat.

Day 04: Gulmarg

After breakfast and carrying box lunches, depart for an excursion to Gulmarg – the large meadow of Gulmarg is 52 kms from Srinagar at 2730 meters. The name means 'meadow of flowers' and in spring it's just that. This is also an excellent trekking base and in winter it's India's premier skiing resort. There are pleasant pine forests with excellent views over the Kashmir Valley, Nanga Parbath, is visible to the north and Haramukh and Sunset Peak are visible to the southeast. Return to the houseboat in the evening for overnight.

Day 05: Pahalgam

After breakfast, depart for Pahalgam about 95 kms from Srinagar and at 2130 mts located on the banks of the beautiful Lidder River and surrounded by soaring, fir-covered mountains with snow-capped peaks, Pahalgam is an ideal base for treks to Kolahai Glacier or Amarnath Caves. Pahalgam is also famous for its many shepherds. They are a common sight, driving their flocks of sheep along the path all around town.

Overnight in the hotel.

Day 06: Pahalgam

Day at leisure in Pahalgam to enjoy the serene surrounding of this lovely hill station. Overnight in the hotel.

Day 07: Srinagar

After breakfast, drive back to Srinagar arriving the Houseboat in the afternoon. Overnight in the Houseboat.

Day 08: Delhi

After a leisurely breakfast, transfer to the airport for you flight to Delhi. In the evening, depart Delhi for your next destination.

Day 1 : Abroad - Chennai

Arrive Chennai International airport. On arrival, the guest will be met by our representative and checked in to the hotel.

Overnight at hotel.

Day 2 : Chennai

Chennai - the sprawling and gracious city on the "Bay of Bengal" is the fourth largest city in India. Visit the Fort St. George once a stronghold of the British, San Thome Cathedral, Marina Beach and the beautiful Mylapore temple. Overnight at hotel.

Day 3: Chennai - Pondicherry

After breakfast drive to Pondicherry (162 km), enroute visit Kancheepuram and Mahabalipuram.

Kancheepuram - known as the Golden City of a Thousand Temples, is one of the oldest towns in India.

Continue drive to Pondicherry. Upon arrival in Pondicherry - check into the hotel. Overnight at hotel.

Day 4 : Pondicherry

Pondicherry, was a far-flung outpost of the French maritime empire till the 1950's.

Afternoon tour of Pondicherry - visit Botanical garden, Eglise De Sacre Coeur De Jesus and Sri Aurobindo Ashram. Later visit township of Auroville or the city of Dawn. Designed by a French architect Roger Argon, it is an entirely new concept in education and urban living. Overnight at hotel.

Day 5 : Pondicherry - Tanjore

After breakfast drive to Tanjore (177 kms).

Afternoon sightseeing tour of Tanjore. A Chola king, Raja Raja Chola, who held the throne from 985 to 1016, built the greatest of the empire's 74 temples, the Brahadeeswarar, with its soaring tower over the inner sanctum. This tower rises more than 62 meters (200 feet). On its dome rests a single block of granite weighing 80 tons.

Overnight at hotel

Day 6 : Tanjore - Trichy - Madurai

After breakfast drive to Madurai (178 kms) enroute visit Trichy

City tour of Trichy - visit the 'Rock Fort Temple' which rises abruptly to a height of 273 ft.

Thereafter continue drive to Madurai.

Evening visit Meenakshi temple - to attend the night ceremony at the temple at 9 PM. This is a ceremony that takes place every evening when the temple bronze of Lord Shiva is carried to the bedchamber of Parvati.

Overnight at hotel.

Day 7 : Madurai



Morning, visit the Meenakshi temple one of the biggest temple complexes in India - 46 ft. long by 790 ft broad built in the 17th Century. Also visit the Palace of Tirumala Nayak which is an example of the architectural mastery of the Nayaks - a blend of Hindu and Saracen architecture. Afternoon at leisure.

Overnight at hotel.

Day 8 : Madurai - Periyar

Morning drive to Periyar (177 kms).

Periyar - Sprawling across 777 sq. kms of the Cardamom Hills of the Western Ghats, Thekkady is the home to one of the largest wildlife reserves in India.

Afternoon boatcruise on the Lake of the famous Periyar Wildlife Sanctuary to see wild life. Periyar Lake or reservoir created by a dam on Periyar River is the heart of the Wildlife Sanctuary. Wild elephants, Asiatic Deer, Black Buck and even Tigers come to shores of the lake for a drink.

Overnight at hotel.

Day 09 : Periyar - Munnar

Morning drive to Munnar (180 km) .

Munnar - is the beautiful hillstation housing world's highest tea - growing estates. Beyond these estates are rich tropical forests that houses an assortment of wildlife such as Nilgiri Langur, Sambhar, Gaur, Elephant and Lion-tailed Macaques. Afternoon visit the popular tea estates.

Overnight at hotel.

Day 10 : Munnar

Morning, visit ERAVIKULAM National Park (16 kms) - it is the home of the endangered Nilgiri Tahr (a type of mountain goat) that roams on a stretch of grassland or is seen climbing the pinnacles of the undulating hills.

Rest of the day at leisure.

Overnight at hotel.

Day 11 : Munnar - Cochin

Morning drive to Cochin (160 km).

Evening witness the Kathakali dance performance - Kathakali is a unique dance which has a 2000 year old history with more than 100 different 'mudras' or gestures.

Overnight at hotel.

Day 12 : Cochin

Morning tour of Cochin or "Kochi"- the palm green, commercial captial of Kerala is known as the " Queen of the Arabian Sea ". From time immemorial, Arabs, Chinese, Dutch, British & Portuguese seafarers followed the sea route to Kochi & left their impression on the town. Visit the Dutch Palace, the Jewish Synagogue, the Church of St. Francis, the Bolghatty Palace & the famous Chinese fishing nets.

Afternoon free for a stroll in Jew town.

Overnight at hotel

Day 13 : Cochin - Mumbai

Depart Cochin by flight. On arrival in Mumbai, the guests will be met by our representative and transferred to the hotel. Rest of the day at leisure.

Overnight at hotel.



Day 14 : Mumbai

Morning, one hour boat ride across Mumbai Harbour brings you to the lush green Elephanta Island. Here, visit some of the huge and intricately carved Elephanta Caves that date back to the 8th century.

Afternoon, City tour of Mumbai - the great port city with its Victorian Gothic buildings from the British Raj Era mingling with the modern. The tour includes Gateway of India overlooking the Harbour, the Towers of Silence, Marine Drive and the Dhobi Ghat. Also visit Mani Bhawan, a small museum dedicated to the life and works of Mahatma Gandhi, and the bustling Crawford Market.

Halebid and Belur temples - The Chenna Kesava temple of Belur built 900 years ago is an exquisite example of Hoysala art. Halebid's 12th century Hoysaleswara and Kedareshwara temples are masterpieces of Hindu art.

Day 8 : Hassan - Chikmagalur

Depart for the beautiful town of Chikmagalur nestled in the Baba Budan hills. Chikmagalur is a calm, serene town full of scenic surprises - hills, valleys, streams and snow-white coffee blossoms. On arrival, check-in at the hotel. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 9 : Hassan - Hospet

Morning drive to Hospet. Afternoon visit Hampi - a World Heritage Centre. Hampi is the most beautiful and evocative of all the ruins in Karnataka. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 10 : Hospet - Badami

Morning drive to Badami (103 km). Here the cave temples are hewn out of solid rock, in a magical setting of hills above a lovely reservoir. On arrival, visit the Aihole and Pattadakal. Aihole - famous as the cradle of Indian temple architecture - has over 125 temples, all intricately carved and rich in detail. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 11 : Badami - Goa

Morning drive to Goa (198 km). On arrival, check-in at the hotel. Afternoon at leisure for your own activities. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 12 : Goa

Morning sightseeing of Goa Churches and Temples. Overnight at the hotel.

Periyar - an artificial lake or reservoir created by a dam on Periyar River is the heart of the Wildlife Sanctuary. Wild Elephants, Asiatic Deer, Black Buck and even Tigers come to shores of the lake for a drink. Return to hotel for breakfast. After breakfast we drive for Agra visiting enroute Sikandra. Arrival at Agra after some rest at the hotel, we set out to see the majestic Agra Fort & Itimad-ud-Daulah. Its time now to see the most charming tribute of Love THE TAJ MAHAL with the colours of sunset. Return back to the hotel. Overnight in the comfort of your hotel room.

Day 04: Bharatpur: Bird Sanctuary

Drive for Bharatpur visiting enroute Fatehpur Sikri. At Bharatpur visit Keolodeo Bird Sanctuary - One of the finest bird parks in the world, Bharatpur Bird Sanctuary (Keoladeo Ghana National Park) is a reserve that offers protection to faunal species as well. Nesting indigenous water- birds as well as migratory water birds and waterside birds, this sanctuary is also inhabited by Sambar, Chital, Nilgai and Boar. Overnight at Bharatpur.

Day 05: Ranthambhore National Park

Drive for Ranthambhore to look for the elusive tiger!. In the afternoon, enjoy jeep ride into the Jungle. Overnight at Ranthambhore.

Day 06: Ranthambhore: Jungle Safari.

Day is especially reserved for you to witness the mystery & drama of the Jungle on a Jeep to view wildlife of Ranthambore National Park. Later, return back to the hotel. Overnight in the hotel.

Day 07: Jaipur: Rajasthani Dinner.

After breakfast we drive for Jaipur. Arrival at Jaipur . Rest at the hotel. Overnight in Jaipur.

Day 08: Jaipur: Sightseeing.

In the first half we visit the Royal Palace Museum, Jantar Mantar and Hawa Mahal and the Amber Fort with elephant ride. Afterwards we visit The City Palace complex. Evening free. Overnight in the hotel.

Day 09: Jodhpur: Leisure.

Drive for Jodhpur. Afternoon sightseeing of Jodhpur visiting Mehrangarh Fort, Jaswant Thada and Clock Tower. Overnight at Jodhpur.



Day 10: Jodhpur -Bishnoi - protectors of wildlife

Enjoy a full day excursion tour to Bishnoi village. Visit potters and weaver's villages. The most remarkable of the desert people are the Bishnoi, who believe in non-violence to all living organisms. Overnight at Jodhpur.

Day 11: Jodhpur-Jaisalmer: Osiyan

Drive towards Jaisalmer visiting enroute Osiyan. Overnight at Jaisalmer.

Day 12: Jaisalmer: Sightseeing.

In the sightseeing tour visit inhabited Fort, the Temples, Havelis, Palaces, Gadsisar Tank and the maze of lanes and by-lanes. Afterwards explore the market. In the evening enjoy Camel ride over Sand Dunes. Overnight at Jaisalmer.

Day 13: Gajner: Wild life.

Drive straight for Gajner and on arrival visit Gajner Wildlife Sanctuary. The lake and forested hills of this reserve, situated 32 kms from Bikaner on the Jaisalmer Road, are inhabited by wildfowl and a number of deer and antelopes. Imperial Sand Grouse migrate here in winter. In the sanctuary you can even see wild boar, black bucks, the majestic sand grouse, nilgai and chinkara. This place of scenic beauty has hillocks encompassing it and housing a lovely lake. On the banks of this lake is an old summer palace which is used as a hotel now. Overnight at Gajner.

Day 14: Bikaner:

Do sightseeing of Bikaner visiting Junagarh Fort, Ganga Golden Museum and Camel Breeding Farm. Overnight in the hotel.

Day 15: Mandawa - Shekhawati region.

Mandawa is a small town in the heart of Shekhawati region. The place is known not only for its havelis but also for its Fort Palace. The structure of the palace reminds of the cultural and social importance of this region in the past. Of the havelis, the most important are the Chokhani, Ladia, Binsidhar Newatia, and Gulab Rai Ladia Haveli.

Day 16: Sariska : Depart for Sariska National Park Sariska's forests are typical of the Aravallis with their undulating terrain of low hills, steep escarpments, wide valleys and hill plateaus. The beautiful Siliserh Lake runs along the edge of the reserve, with a quaint hunting lodge overlooking it. The Sariska park is home to numerous carnivores including Leopard, Wild Dog, Jungle Cat, Hyena, Jackal, and Tiger.

Day 17: Drive back to Delhi Airport for your flight back home.
