APRIL 28 – MAY 10, 2009

April 28, 2009 – Day 1 – Beijing

Arrive Beijing, transfer to Beijing Hotel 5* or similar.

April 29 – Day 2 – Beijing

Breakfast at hotel. Visit **Tian An Men Square** – the Square of the Gate of Heavenly Peace, the largest square in the World in the heart of Beijing; the **Forbidden City**, officially known as the **Palace Museums (Gugong)**, China's most magnificent architectural complex completed in 1420, from which 24 emperors ruled for nearly 500 years – **including the nicest private room recently open for a maximum of 50 persons per day**; **buffet lunch** at **Grand Hotel de Beijing**. Visit the **Summer Palace** - its sprawling grounds served the Qing Dynasty as an imperial retreat from the stifling summer confines of the Forbidden City.

April 30 – Day 3 - Beijing

Breakfast at hotel. Visit the **Great Wall at Mutianyu** including round trip **cable car** for the initial phase. **Lunch** at **Xiao Long Pu** restaurant, visit **the largest cloisonne factory in Beijing**.
Evening, **Peking duck dinner** at traditional **Heppingmen** restaurant.

May 01 – Day 4 – Beijing / Xian

Breakfast at hotel.
Visit the **Temple of Heaven** where the emperors of the Ming and Qing dynasty would visit twice a year to pray for good harvest. **Hutong** tour including riding a “**pedicab**”. **Lunch** at a local restaurant. Transfer to airport for flight to **Xian**.
Arrive Xian, **foot massage**.
Transfer to **Hotel Sofitel Xian 5***.

May 2 – Day 5 - Xian

Breakfast at hotel.
Visit the **Terracotta Warriors Museum** – considered the 8th wonder of the World. **Lunch** at a local restaurant.
Visit the **Dayan Pagoda** known as the “Wild Goose Pagoda”. Visit a **jade factory**.
Evening, the wonderful **Tang Dynasty show and dinner**.

May 3 – Day 6 - Xian / Chongqing / Yangtze River Cruise

Breakfast at hotel. Visit the **Xian City Wall**; the **Mosque** – originally built in the 8th century. **Lunch** at a local restaurant. Visit the **Han Dynasty Museum**.

Transfer to airport for flight to **Chongqing**.
Arrive Chongqing, panoramic view of the city. Dinner at a local restaurant (time permitting). Transfer to **Victoria Cruise - Victoria Jenna**, the latest addition to the fleet inaugurating on April 24, 2009 - www.victoriacruises.com.

May 04 – Day 7 – Yangtze River Cruise
