**14 OCT 09 ARRIVAL BANGKOK (D)**

Arrive in Bangkok airport. Met by our guide and transferred to **Hotel Sofitel Silom** for check-in. Enjoy the sites and ambiance of the **Chao Phraya River of Kings** while cruising in style on the **Manohra Rice Barge** and enjoying a **delicious Thai dinner with candlelight**. Overnight in Bangkok Hotel Sofitel Silom.

**15 OCT 09 BANGKOK DEPARTURE - ARRIVE YANGON (B, L)**

**Breakfast** at hotel. Our guide will meet us at our hotel and assist with our transfer to the airport for your departure flight to Yangon.

Arrive **Yangon** and transfer to hotel **Governor's Residence Yangon**.

Yangon, formerly known as Rangoon, is still a relatively quiet and charming city. Its impressive colonial and spiritual heritage makes Yangon one of the most fascinating and authentic capitals of South East Asia.

After checking into our hotel and with a short break to freshen up, depart the hotel for **lunch** at a local restaurant.

This afternoon a first look at the Yangon takes you to the **National Museum and Kyaukhtatgyi Pagoda's 70m long reclining Buddha**. End our first day in Myanmar with a **sunset tour** of the country's holiest of monuments, the **Shwedagon Pagoda** with its golden stupa covered with 60 tons of pure leaf gold. Overnight in Yangon Governor's Residence Yangon.

**16 OCT 09 YANGON - BAGAN (B, L)**

After breakfast at the hotel transfer to Yangon's Mingaladon Airport for our flight to **Bagan (Nyaung Oo)**.

Thousands of ancient stupas and temples in this area make Bagan one of the most remarkable archaeological sites in Asia. From the 11<sup>th</sup> till 13<sup>th</sup> century, when Bagan was the capital of Myanmar, the rulers constructed huge stupas and temples, many of which are still standing today on the banks of the Irrawaddy River.

On arrival Bagan we head to **Tayokye Pyay** for a first overview over the plain of Bagan.

We continue with the **Shwezigon Pagoda** and its magnificent golden stupa, followed by **Wetkyi-In Gubyaukgyi**, a cave temple with exquisite jatakas murals paintings and the elegant **Htilominlo Temple** noted for its fine plaster carvings and glazed sandstone decorations.

Lunch at a local restaurant

This afternoon we visit **Ananda**, an architectural masterpiece of the early-style temple, and **Ananda Okkyaung**, one of the few surviving brick monasteries from the early Bagan period.

We end our full day of touring with a **horse carriage ride** among the thousands of temples and stupas starting at Ananda and passing **Thatbyinnyu**, the highest temple in Bagan. This massive Dhammayangyi temple is noted for its remarkable brickwork and Sulamani.

We enjoy **sunset** over the site from one of the open **upper terraces in Bagan**. A marvelous **photo opportunity!** Overnight in Bagan at the **Aureum Palace Resort**.

**17 OCT 09 BAGAN (B, L, D)**

After **breakfast** at the hotel we visit the colorful **Nyaung Oo Market** before proceeding to **Myinkaba Village**. We go for a walk through the village and have the opportunity to visit the

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local sites (**Gubyaukgi**, with some of the oldest mural paintings, **Manuha and Nanpaya**) as well as look into the production process of **lacquer ware**, one of the best-known Myanmar handicrafts in one of the local family workshops.

**Lunch** at a local restaurant

This afternoon we visit the countryside village of **Minnanthu**, the least visited area in Bagan, with temples such as **Payathonzu**, with its unusual architecture and Tantric Buddhism influence, **Lemyethna and Nandamannya**, before heading to the riverside near **Nyaung U Village** where we board a **local boat** for a slow **cruise down the Ayeyarwaddy before sunset**.

**Dinner at Nanda restaurant with its puppet show**

Overnight in Bagan Aureum Palace Resort.

**18 OCT 09**

**BAGAN - MANDALAY**

**(B, L)**

After **breakfast** at the hotel transfer to Nyaung Oo Airport for the flight to **Mandalay**.

On arrival, visits start with the **Mahamuni Pagoda**, famous for its venerable statue of Buddha covered with gold leaf. Mandalay has long been known as a center of skilled craftsmanship and in former times supplied the Royal Court. A tour of traditional workshops includes crafts such as **woodcarving, marble masonry, Kalaga tapestry and gold leaf making**.

**Lunch** at a local restaurant. In the afternoon visit the **Kuthodaw Pagoda** with its 729 marble stone slabs of Buddhist scriptures (the world's biggest "book") and **Shwenandaw Monastery**, noted for its exquisite woodcarving. End the day with a view of the **sunset from Mandalay Hill**.

Overnight in Mandalay **Mandalay Hill Resort**.

**19 OCT 09**

**MANDALAY - HEHO - INLE LAKE**

**(B, L)**

**Breakfast** at the hotel. In the morning transfer to Mandalay Airport for our flight to **Heho**.

From Heho a 1-hour scenic drive leads to **Nyaung Shwe**, the gateway village to Inle Lake. Stop at the wooden **Shwe Yan Pyay Monastery** on the way.

Board a **private motorboat** to head out onto Inle Lake, one of Myanmar's most spectacular sights. We pass villages built on stilts over the lake, which are mostly inhabited by **Intha people**, the leg-rowing fishermen of the lake and see the floating gardens built up from strips of water hyacinth and mud and anchored to the bottom with bamboo poles.

**Lunch** at a local restaurant.

Stops for visits at the **Nga Hpe Chaung (jumping cats) Monastery** and its Shan Buddhas and **Phaung Daw Oo Pagoda**, the lake's main sanctuary.

/Other visits include the weaving village of **Inpawkhone**, a **cheroot factory** where the typical Burmese cigars are made by hand. If time allows we go for an improvised walk through one of the villages. Overnight on Inle Lake at the **Inle Princess Resort**.

**20 OCT 09**

**INDEIN - INLE LAKE**

**(B, L)**

After **breakfast**, we head to the **morning market on the lake**. Rotating around villages on and near the lake in a 5 day rhythm, a colorful market visited by lake inhabitants and surrounding hill tribes is held daily (except on new and full moon days).

From the middle of the lake, continue down a small canal leading to the **Paoh village of In Dein**. After a walk around the village, passing a local school, take the covered stairway to the beautiful **Alaung Sitthou area** where ancient stupas are partly covered by vegetation. From here there is a magnificent view over the lake.

Return to the lake and in the afternoon, and at leisure in the afternoon to enjoy the resort.

Overnight on Inle Lake at the **Inle Princess Resort**.

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**21 OCT 09 INLE LAKE - HEHO - YANGON (B, L)**

After **breakfast** at the hotel we board a **private boat** to transfer to **Nyaung Shwe** then by private air conditioned vehicle to **Heho** for our flight back to **Yangon** (ETD/ETA : 1010h/1120h). On arrival Yangon we transfer to our hotel - Residence Yangon for check in.

**Lunch** at our hotel

This afternoon we free time to stroll through the Bogyoke Market (formerly known as Scott Market) (closed on full moon days and public holidays) before exploring downtown Yangon with it's hustling and bustling people and sights of the former British colonial homes and buildings.

Overnight in Yangon at the Governor's Residence Yangon Hotel.

**22 OCT 09 YANGON DEPARTURE - ARRIVAL HANOI (B, D)**

After **breakfast** at the hotel we transfer to Yangon's Mingalardon airport for our onwards flight to **Hanoi**, Vietnam via Bangkok.

Arrive Hanoi's Noi Bai airport and after clearing Vietnam immigrations and customs we meet our guide and transfer to the **Inter-Continental Hanoi**.

Remainder of day at leisure. [Enjoy dinner at Press Club Restaurant.](#)

Overnight in Hanoi at the Inter-Continental Hanoi.

**23 OCT 09 HANOI FULL DAY CITY TOUR (B, L)**

This morning meet your guide at your hotel and depart on your tour after **breakfast**. Your first stop will be **Ho Chi Minh's Mausoleum** (closed Mondays and Fridays), as well as his private residence from 1954 until 1969. The wooden ethnic minority style house, which was built on stilts, is surrounded by lovely peaceful gardens. In the same complex you will see the **One Pillar Pagoda**, founded by King Ly Thai To in 1049. This structure has become an important symbol for the people of Hanoi.

Your tour continues to the **National Fine Arts Museum**, located in colonial France's former Ministry of Information, which has an eclectic mix of contemporary Vietnamese art, religious pieces, lacquer-ware and sculptures. Your next stop will be the **Temple Of Literature**, Vietnam's first university. Constructed in 1070, the gardens and well-preserved architecture offer a relaxing glimpse into Vietnam's past.

Enjoy **lunch** at a local restaurant before continuing on to **Hoa Lo Prison** (formerly known as the "Hanoi Hilton" during the American war). Your tour will also include the **Buddhist Tran Quoc Pagoda on West Lake** (one of the oldest in Vietnam) and **Quan Thanh Temple** (Taoist, dating from the Ly Dynasty). The last stop of the day before returning to your hotel will be the **Museum of Ethnology** where you observe Vietnam's diverse culture through the Museum's unique presentation of artifacts and dress used in daily life.

Enjoy a **one hour tour by cyclo**, a chauffeur-pedalled tricycle, through **Hanoi's Old Quarter**, also known as "36 streets". This bustling area of narrow streets and alleys is home to literally thousands of small businesses and shopkeepers. It's a great place to explore, especially by cyclo, with plenty of photo opportunities all around you.

Attend a traditional **water puppet show**, a uniquely northern Vietnamese art form especially designed for depicting scenes from rural life and episodes of national history

Overnight in Hanoi at the Inter-Continental Hanoi.

**24 OCT 09 HANOI- HALONG BAY- EMERAUDE CRUISE (B, L, D)**

After **breakfast**, your early morning departure from your hotel to **Halong Bay** takes you on a journey through the rich farmlands of the Red River Delta. You observe everyday life of **Vietnamese Villages** as you see villagers work the local rice fields, take live pigs to market on

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bicycles or motorbikes, and plough the fields with their large water buffaloes. Arrive in Halong and board the **Emeraude**, a wonderful replica of one of the classic steamships of the colonial era of French Indochina. A welcome **drink** is served on the sundeck. With 37 luxurious air-conditioned cabins, a restaurant, two bars and a sundeck, this is the ultimate Halong Bay experience. **Lunch** is served on board at 1:00pm. While cruising on the emerald green waters of the bay try a traditional Vietnamese foot massage or **high tea** which is served on the sundeck in the late afternoon. Enjoy watching the **sun set**. A scrumptious **buffet dinner** is served between 8:00pm and 11:00pm. Before retiring to your cabin, return to the sundeck for a nightcap and take in the quiet serene beauty of the stars. Overnight on board the **Emeraude Cruise**.

**25 OCT 09 HALONG BAY- DANANG - HOIAN (B)**

Early morning offers a **Tai Chi** class on the sundeck between 6:00am and 7:00am. If Thai Chi doesn't interest you, enjoy a fresh **cup of coffee or tea** as you view the awakening of Halong Bay's boat people. A wholesome breakfast is served before cruising back to Halong City. Arrive back at Emeraude's exclusive private pier at 9:30am for disembarkation where your guide waits to take you to the airport for the flight to **Danang**.

Transfer directly to **Hoian** for check in at the **Life Hoian Resort**.

Overnight in Hoi An at the Life Hoian Resort.

**26 OCT 09 HOIAN (B, L)**

After breakfast, your half day tour takes you through Hoi An, once a major Asian trading port in the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries. **Hoi An's** architecture and relaxed lifestyle have changed little over the years. Take a leisurely walking tour of the ancient town center and visit the sites of **former merchants' homes**, a **400 year-old Japanese Covered Bridge**, and a **Chinese Communal Hall**. Before you return to your hotel enjoy browsing and shopping in the one of the most colourful local marketplaces in all of SE Asia.

**Enjoy lunch at Nam Long restaurant.** Rest of day is free for own leisure.

Overnight in Hoian at the Life Hoi An Resort.

**27 OCT 09 HOIAN - DANANG - HO CHI MINH CITY (SAIGON) (B)**

**Breakfast** at hotel. Transfer to the airport for a short flight to dynamic **Ho Chi Minh City** (Saigon). Upon arrival, transfer to hotel **Caravelle**.

Today's half day tour takes you to visit the world famous **Cu Chi Tunnels**. The incredible underground tunnel network was constructed by Vietnamese resistance fighters (Viet Cong) during their long struggle for independence.

Rest of day is at own leisure. Overnight Saigon at the Caravelle Hotel.

**28 OCT 09 SAIGON HALF DAY CITY TOUR (B, L, D)**

**Breakfast** at hotel. Ho Chi Minh City has more to offer than meets the eye. Your **half day tour** will take you to the **War Museum** and the **former Presidential Palace**. From the palace you will go on foot (your car will be available at all times) to visit the major sights of colonial Ho Chi Minh City including the **Notre Dame Cathedral**, **Old Saigon Post Office**, **Dong Khoi Street** (formerly Rue Catinat), the **Continental Hotel House**, and **City Hall**. After this historical visit enjoy a scoop of wonderful **ice cream at Fanny's**, a quaint little parlour with French atmosphere, before exploring the trendy **boutiques and shops on Ton That Thiep Street**.

**Enjoy light lunch with Pho 24.** Afternoon's free for shopping and own exploration.

**Farewell dinner at Temple Club restaurant.** Overnight in Saigon at the Caravelle Hotel.

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**29 OCT 09 SAIGON - SIEM REAP (B, D)**

**Breakfast** at hotel. Transfer to the airport for our international flight to **Siem Reap**. Arrive Siem Reap, after going through immigration and customs, transfer to the **Sokha Angkor Hotel**. **Dinner** at hotel. Overnight.

**30 OCT 09 SIEM REAP (B, L)**

**Breakfast** at hotel. Morning visit **Victory Gate**, the twin temples of **Thomanon** and **Chau Sai Tevada**, **Takeo** and **Ta Prohm**.

**Lunch** at hotel.

Afternoon visit **North Gate of Angkor Thom**, continue the tour to **Preah Khan Temple**. Visit **Neak Pean**, **Ta Som**, **Mebon Oriental**. **Foot Massage** one hour in the city.

Overnight at Sofitel Royal Angkor Hotel.

**31 OCT 09 SIEM REAP (B, D)**

**Breakfast** at hotel. Full day visit to **Bayon Temple**, **Royal Enclosure** (outside), **Elephants Terrace** and **Terrace of Leper King**.

Afternoon visit **Angkor Wat** and sunset view from the top of **Bakheng Temple**.

**Dinner with show** at **Angkor Village Hotel**. Overnight at Sofitel Royal Angkor Hotel.

**01 NOV 09 SIEM REAP - BANGKOK (B, L)**

**Breakfast** at hotel. Morning excursion by boat on **Tonle Sap Lake** to visit fishing and floating village and **Ox Cart** tour to visit local village.

**Lunch** at local restaurant.

Afternoon visit **Le Artisan D'Angkor** and old market. Transfer to airport for flight to **Bangkok**. Arrive in Bangkok airport. We will be met by our guide and transferred to your hotel for check-in at the Sofitel Silom. Overnight.

**02 NOV 09 BANGKOK (B)**

**Breakfast** at hotel. Free day at leisure. Overnight in Bangkok at Sofitel Silom.

**03 NOV 09 BANGKOK DEPARTURE (B)**

**Breakfast** at hotel, your guide will meet you at your hotel and assist with your transfer to the airport for your departure flight.

Please bring new US Dollar bills ("big heads" instead of "small heads") and with series numbers not starting with CB as these are not accepted in Myanmar due to rumours these series are counterfeit.
2. Furthermore please inform passengers that they should NOT change money at the exchange booth at the airport just after immigration, as the market rate in town is MUCH better.
3. Travellers to Myanmar are required to have a travel insurance covering the cost of medical evacuation flights.
5. Visas are required by all visitors to Myanmar. A **visa must be obtained before entering Myanmar**. Passport must be valid 6 months after arrival date.
6. The schedules of domestic flights in Myanmar are provided as an indication only. Once a booking is confirmed we can provide more precise timings, but these remain nevertheless subject to change without notice by the airlines until travelling date. It might therefore in some cases be necessary to amend our program and itinerary due to such schedule changes. We thank you for your understanding.
